## STUDENT DRIVING

Students may drive automobiles to and from school. They may not be driven during the school day without the consent of the parent and principal. They may not transport another student during the school day unless both the student and parent/guardian have granted consent and properly checked out of school.

A student may use the school parking lot subject to the following conditions:

- A student must register the car in the school office. The student must possess a valid Washington
  driver's license and show evidence that there is a liability and property damage insurance coverage
  on the vehicle and acknowledge that he/she will assume full responsibility for any comprehensive or
  collision claims that may occur while on school property.
- 2. Students may not occupy a vehicle (without permission) during the school day.
- In terms of student conduct rules, "possession" of alcoholic beverages, illegal chemical substances or opiates, firearms or a dangerous weapon shall also extend to a student's vehicle.
- 4. Access to student parking lots during class time is prohibited.
- The Anacortes School District may charge a nominal parking fee annually to students wishing to use school parking lots during the school day.
- Students in violation of parking regulations may be subjected to ticketing and towing. Included in such offenses would be parking in staff lots/spaces, visitor spaces, lanes/spaces reserved for Anacortes School District maintenance workers, and occupying handicapped spaces.

A student who does not conform to the above rules shall be subject to corrective action.
